GENERAL NOTICE OF REGISTERABLE INTERESTS

Keinton Mandeville Parish Council's Code of Conduct adopted 5 November 2019

A member of Keinton Mandeville Parish Council (the Council) give notice that

Either

I have no registerable interests which are required to be declared under the Council's Code of Conduct, and I have put 'none' where I have no such interests under any heading. ✓

Or

I have set out below under the appropriate headings my interests, and those of my spouse / civil partner (or person with whom I am living with as such) of which I am aware which I am required to declare under the Council's Code of Conduct. These include any disclosable pecuniary interests under section 29-31 of the localism act 2011, and The Relevant Authorities (Disclosable Pecuniary Interests) Regulations 2012, and I have put 'none' where I have no such interests under any heading.

Note

1. Where you consider that information relating to any of your interests is a 'Sensitive Interest' you need not include that interest provided that you have consulted with the Monitoring Officer and he agrees that it need not be included. 'Sensitive interest' is an interest which could create or is likely to create a serious risk that you or a person connected with you may be subject to violence or intimidation.

- 2. Where the interest is no longer a 'Sensitive Interest' you must notify the Monitoring Officer within 28 days of that change.
- 3. This form gives general guidance but is not comprehensive. The Parish Council's code of conduct gives precise requirements. The Localism Act and the Regulations named above should be referred to where necessary. Continuation sheets should be used where required and clearly marked.

1. Employment, Office, Trade, Profession or Vocation

1.1 You should disclose any employment, office, trade, profession or vocation carried on for profit or gain, including the name of any person or body who employs or has appointed you (and of your spouse / civil partner or person with whom you are living as such of which you are aware)

2.1 You should declare any payment or provision of any other financial benefit (other than from the council) made or provided within the last 12 months in respect of expenses incurred by you in carrying out your duties as a member or towards your election expenses interest (and of your spouse / civil partner or person with whom you are living as such of which you are aware) Note- this includes any payment or financial benefit from a trade union

8.1 I understand that I must, within 28 days of becoming aware of any new or change in the above interests, including any change in relation to a sensitive interest, provide written notification thereof to the District Council's monitoring officer.

8.2 I recognise that it is a breach of the Council's Code of Conduct to:

- 1) Omit information that ought to be given in this notice
- 2) Provide information that is false or misleading
- 3) Fail to give further notices in order to
 - Bring up to date information given in this notice
 - Declare an interest that I acquire after the date of this notice and have to declare

and that any breach of the code of conduct can be referred to the Standards Committee.

I understand that failure (without reasonable excuse) to register or disclose any disclosable pecuniary interest in accordance with section 30 (1) or 31 (2), (3) or (7) of the Localism Act 2011, or participating in any discussion or vote in contravention of section 31 (4) of the Localism Act 2011, or taking any steps in contravention of section 31(8) of the Localism Act is a criminal offence and risks a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale (currently £5000) or disqualification as a member for a period not exceeding 5 years.
